COURSE VERIFICATION

Log in to Parent Access (PAC). Click on the 4-yr. plan tab or the Course Request tab. At the top of the screen, click on the red bar in order to generate the ACA. Once the ACA generates, click to approve. You and your student should review the ACA and its requirements prior to approving all advanced courses. Once the ACA is approved, you will be able to see confirmation in the 4-year plan in the box of courses for the upcoming school year.

Watch the Advanced Course Agreement Video

If your student selects an advanced course that is different from the course for which he/she was advised, you and your student will be required to view an Advanced Course Agreement video that corresponds to the advanced course through CANVAS. Videos and information regarding these videos will be sent to you by March 22, 2019.

All ACAs must be signed and videos must be viewed prior to April 5, 2019. Students without a signed ACA will be removed from all advanced courses.

Changes to the Course Verification Sheet

If you find an error in the course requests or would like to make a change, please email your student's high school counselor (see the bottom of the page) the request and she will make the change in your student's 4-yr. plan. The change should show up in your student's 4-yr. plan within 3 school days.

March 8 – 1st course verification available in PAC; Advanced Course Agreement Form Available in PAC
April 5 – Deadline to review course requests, to electronically sign ACA, and to view Advanced Course video(s) if required.

April 12 – 2nd course verification posted in PAC with changes and removal of ACA courses not electronically signed.

April 26 – Deadline for all changes to course requests and submission of ACA's. No more changes will be accepted after this date.

May 3 – Final course requests will be posted in PAC

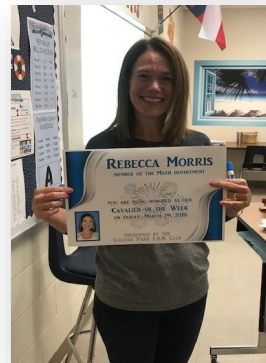

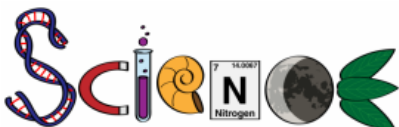

ROBOTICS TEAMS TEXAS TORQUE AND CAVBOTS HONORED AT COMPETITION

College Park High School's two FIRST Robotics Competition teams, rookie team 7492 CavBots and fifteen-year veteran team 1477 Texas Torque were both incredibly successful at their second competition of the season in Del Rio, Texas this weekend.

The 10 CavBots students at the competition, cheered on by dedicated parents and helped by CP teachers Mr. McKnight and Mr. Haygood, quickly rose to seed 6 out of 40 teams during qualification matches. Their consistent performance and strong engineering skills helped them become the alliance captain of the 5th seed alliance. Unfortunately, they were knocked out in the quarterfinals—but not without a fight! They powered through two tough matches, often overtaking their higher-ranked opponents. Their achievements didn't stop there; they were honored with the Rookie All Star award, which commends new teams for their commitment to FIRST principles, sustainability, and engineering. This award is a difficult one to earn and judges are not required to award this at a competition. The CavBots made an immense achievement at Del Rio, and have already proven themselves as one of the best rookie teams in the state of Texas. In fact, they are currently ranked 29 out of the 183 teams in Texas!

Texas Torque also performed very well. After going undefeated in qualification rounds, they made it to rank 1 and ended up as the captain of the 1st seed alliance. They went on to win both of their quarterfinal matches. Facing aggressive defense and quick plays from their opponents, Texas Torque and their alliance partners were unfortunately defeated in the semifinals. Nevertheless, they were recognized as a runner-up for the Safety Award, and they later won the Chairman's Award, the most prestigious award in FIRST! The Chairman's Award recognizes veteran teams with outstanding outreach programs that help spread STEM in a gracious and professional way. With the conclusion of this competition, Texas Torque is now ranked 9th in Texas.

Both CavBots and Texas Torque qualify for the FIRST in Texas District Championship in Austin April 3rd-6th. Congratulations to both teams, and good luck at the State Championships!

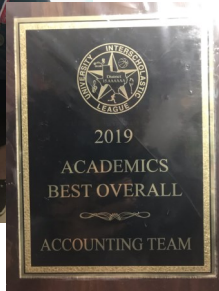
