uing through February 6th. The plans will be made available during the selection window so students can edit and revise their courses for the coming year.

- ◇ On **January 12th** there will be an **Incoming 9th grade Parent Information** night starting at 6:30 on the Auditorium simultaneously with a Spanish Parent Information Meeting in the LGI.
- ◇ On **January 26th** there will be an **Upperclassmen Parent Information** night starting at 6:30 pm in the Auditorium simultaneously with a Spanish Parent Information Meeting in the LGI.
- ◇ On **February 2nd**, course information will also be available at our **"CP Showcase"** from 5:30 pm-7:00 pm . There will be a Department/Class Fair from 5:30-7:00 to inform parents and students of core course and elective offerings.
- ◇ Counselors will also be available during this same time for a help session with parents and students.
- ◇ From 6:00-6:30, there will be a presentation for students and parents interested in learning more about Dual Credit courses offered.
- ◇ From 6:30-7:00, Dr. Hersperger and department chairmen, along with our AP Ambassadors, will be hosting a short presentation regarding advanced level classes and course expectations.

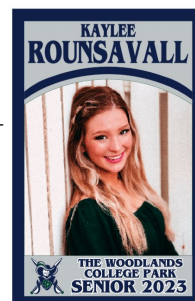

Tardy Policy

Students are expected to be in their assigned classrooms when the tardy bell rings. Each student is allowed six tardies per semester, and each of those six tardies is a warning. The purpose of the warnings is to help students deal with mishaps in the hall, bad weather, heavy traffic, etc. When a student exceeds six tardies, the student will begin receiving consequences from their Assistant Principal. Tardies will start over after each semester. Students seen intentionally being tardy may have all tardy privileges revoked and consequences elevated. Students who drive to school may have additional consequences including suspension of parking and/or loss of parking privileges.

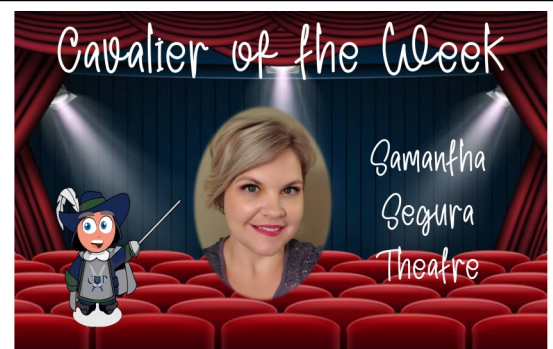


VERIFICATION OF ENROLLEMENT (VOE) INFORMATION:

Obtaining a VOE is the responsibility of the student and the student alone. Students will need to request in person, we will no longer be accepting phone/email request for VOE's.

VOE request must be made 24 hours in advance of when they are needed. To obtain a VOE, have your student come to the AP's office and use the iPad to sign in and select Request VOE.
