
Texas to coach for Tom Herman.

Local Scholarship season is in full swing. Please take advantage

of the opportunities in our community!

Local scholarships are housed in your Naviance account. After you log into Naviance, click on colleges at the top of the page, then click on scholarship search, and you will see all of our local scholarships.

When you do this, all the local scholarships that we have received applications for will appear. I always suggest that you sort them by due date. There are only a few now, but we will receive a TON more as the semester progresses.

Here are some tips:

- 1. Set a reminder to check for new scholarships once a week.
- 2. Read the application to see if you meet the requirements before you start.
- 3. Don't just read the title of the scholarships! For example, the Montgomery County Fair Scholarship does

NOT require fair participation. Neither does the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Scholarship.

4. If you have a parent/quardian to help you read through applications and tell you which ones you meet the

qualifications on, that's super helpful...but not a requirement.

- 5. Most scholarships require some sort of writing/essay—DO NOT FREAK OUT. Most do not have a large requirement of words. Most will want you to write about:
 - A. Why do you need the money?
 - B. What do you want to study/major in/be when you grow up?
- 6. Most will require a resume or for you to write out all your activities-so get it prepared
 - A. Resumes can be longer than one page, that's completely normal.
 - B. Any format organization is fine, as long as it makes sense—you can separate by year, activity, awards, etc.
- 7. Read how to get the application to the committee:
 - A. Some want you to mail and have a postmark (when we mail it) deadline.
 - B. Some will have a received by deadline so you need to plan ahead.
 - C. Some will be turned into the College and Career Center.

Printing is FREE in the CCC. Most of these scholarships will require you to print an application and complete it. You can always print for free in 1619. Ms. Jones is the scholarship guru...she will print and make copies of things for you, teach you how to scan documents with your phone, and explain when to turn things in if you have questions.

Tardy Policy

Students are expected to be in their assigned classrooms when the tardy bell rings. Each student is allowed six tardies per semester, and each of those six tardies is a warning. The purpose of the warnings is to help students deal with mishaps in the hall, bad weather, heavy traffic, etc. When a student exceeds six tardies, the student will begin receiving consequences from their Assistant Principal. Tardies will start over after each semester. Students seen intentionally being tardy may have all tardy privileges revoked and consequences elevated. Students who drive to school may have additional consequences including suspension of parking and/or loss of parking privileges.



LUNCH DROP-OFF

Safety is the upmost importance for our

students. For the safety of our students, all lunches brought in to school for your student will need to be signed in at the front office. Lunches will be taken to the AP office for the students to pick-up. There will be NO food deliveries accepted by any outside vendor. VERIFICATION OF ENROLLMENT (VOE) INFORMATION:

Obtaining a VOE is the responsibility of the student and the student alone . <u>Students will need to request in person, we will no longer be accepting phone/email request for VOE's.</u>

VOE request must be made 24 hours in advance of when they are needed. To obtain a VOE, have your student come to the AP's office and use the iPad to sign in and select Request VOE. 


