TEST OPTIONAL

- Most four year colleges are "test optional" which means that you don't have to submit scores to be **ADMITTED**.
- Scores may be required for scholarship evaluation.
- However, most four year colleges will require scores that are "college ready" before you can take classes.
 - SAT (480 EBRW, 530 MATH)
 - ACT(23 composite with 19 English, 23 composite with 19 Math)
 - TSI (lots of different combinations)

Target

Colleges where the likelihood of your admission is within the normally accepted range at that college

Reach – Above and Beyond

Colleges where your chances of gaining admission are less than 50%

Ideally, the list should consist of no more than 5-7 schools.






Awards are renewable for up to 4 consecutive years (eight total terms).
