## nstructions for Course Registration:

- Course selections for 2024-25 will be downloaded from the student's four-year plan
- Courses listed in Year 4 will be the student's courses for next year.

- Full year courses must have an A and B semester. (Course numbers must match). If a student chooses a half credit course (one semester), they must choose another half credit course for the second semester
- Students should select a total of 7 credits (before alternates)
- Teachers have made course advisements. The advisements are reflected on the student's four-year plan. Students and parents should carefully consider the advisement before making a final course selection.
- Advanced courses will require an Advanced Course Agreement form. These forms will be sent electronically at the close of course registration.
- Some courses may not be available for student selection. Reasons for this may be:
- The course requires a prerequisite that the student has not completed.
- The student is not in the appropriate grade for the course.
- The course is listed elsewhere in the student's four-year plan. (Students will need to edit the plan and move the course.)
- Students must list $\mathbf{3}$ credits of alternates. List in order of priority.
