You will no longer need to call or email (unless a document needs to be attached) to the school. You complete a simple form and questions and click submit!!! We will begin using this process on Tuesday, February 13, 2024. We are still in the process of getting all the fixes in place. Please see the steps below to help guide you through the submission:

AT THIS TIME, THIS IS ONLY TO BE USED TO REPORT ABSENC-ES FOR COLLEGE PARK HIGH SCHOOL. OTHER SCHOOLS WILL COME ON-LINE IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

- 1. Login to your Students SSO
- 2. Locate and click on the following Icon.
- 3. Once in the program, you will select Report a Student Absence (Parent/Guardian Only)
- 4. Follow the on-screen questions and finally click submit.
- 5. The student and parent will receive an email regarding the absence so you can verify it is correct.
- 6. The attendance office will code the absence in the system and everything is done.

Please know that if you are submitting a doctors note or other hard copy information, you will need to scan and email it to the attendance office or have your child drop it off at the attendance office.



Tardy Policy

Students are expected to be in their assigned classrooms when the tardy bell rings. Each student is allowed six tardies per semester, and each of those six tardies is a warning. The purpose of the warnings is to help students deal with mishaps in the hall, bad weather, heavy traffic, etc. When a student exceeds six tardies, the student will begin receiving consequences from their Assistant Principal. Tardies will start over after each semester. Students seen intentionally being tardy may have all tardy privileges revoked and consequences elevated. Students who drive to school may have additional consequences including suspension of parking and/or loss of parking privileges.



LUNCH DROP-OFF POLICY: There will be NO food deliveries accepted by

any outside vendor. Safety is the upmost importance for our students. For the safety of our students, all lunches brought in to school for your student will need to be signed in at the front office. 


