

Course Verification Sheet

Course request verifications have been posted in Parent Access (PAC). Please login to Parent Access (PAC) to view your student's course requests by clicking on Student Plans and then the Course Requests tab. We ask that you review the course requests with your student and verify that they are accurate. Please review your alternates in your 4 year plan to assure they are in the order of preference.

Advanced Course Agreement Process and Access (Students taking an advanced course) The Advanced Course Agreement must be signed in order for the student to remain registered for any advanced course(s). Failure to complete the ACA electronically will result in the advanced course(s) being removed from your student's course requests and 4-year plan prior to the next course request verification. Instructions for electronically signing the Advanced Course Agree-

- ment are the following: 1. Login to the Parent Access Center
- 2. Select the Student Plan Drop Down
- 3. Select Four-Year Plan

Click on the red bar which is at the top of the screen (Course Agreement for Advanced Courses for Plan Year "X") or under course request, click on the Blue Bar below the identified courses If you do not want to approve the course(s), email your child's counselor to have them removed from the advanced course(s)

Watch the Advanced Course Agreement Video

If your student selected an advanced course that is different from the course for which he/she was advised, you and your student will be required to view an Advanced Course Agreement video that corresponds to the advanced course through CANVAS. Videos and information regarding these videos will be sent to you by March 8, 2024.

All ACAs must be signed and videos must be viewed prior to March 28, 2024

Changes to the Course Verification Sheet

If you find an error in the course requests or would like to make a change, please email your student's high school counselor the request and she/he will make the change in your student's 4year plan. The change should show up in your student's 4-year plan within 3 school days.

At the TFA State tournament each event had over 130 students and the following students made it past preliminary rounds.



The success did not stop there when we traveled to Austin for the UIL CX Debate State Championship. We had two teams qualify for this tournament with the team of Olivet Ojajuni and Bailey Fischer going 2-2 on the first day and barely missing the cut. Sarah Synek and Jessie Merriwether advanced to the second day of competition and made it all the way to the semifinal round where they finished 3rd place in the State of Texas at the UIL Meet. CP Speech and Debate will continue its run at the UIL District Spring Meet Tournament on April 3rd where we currently have a 30 point lead for the Speech District Championship.

Tardy Policy

Students are expected to be in their assigned classrooms when the tardy bell rings. Each student is allowed six tardies per semester, and each of those six tardies is a warning. The purpose of the warnings is to help students deal with mishaps in the hall, bad weather, heavy traffic, etc. When a student exceeds six tardies, the student will begin receiving consequences from their Assistant Principal. Tardies will start over after each semester. Students seen intentionally being tardy may have all tardy privileges revoked and consequences elevated. Students who drive to school may have additional consequences including suspension of parking and/or loss of parking privileges.



LUNCH DROP-OFF POLICY: There will be NO food deliveries accepted by

any outside vendor. Safety is the upmost importance for our students. For the safety of our students, all lunches brought in to school for your student will need to be signed in at the front office. 
