

# Tardy Policy

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Students are expected to be in their assigned classrooms when the tardy bell rings. Each student is allowed six tardies per semester, and each of those six tardies is a warning. The purpose of the warnings is to help students deal with mishaps in the hall, bad weather, heavy traffic, etc. When a student exceeds six tardies, the student will begin receiving consequences from their Assistant Principal. Tardies will start over after each semester. Students seen intentionally being tardy may have all tardy privileges revoked and consequences elevated. Students who drive to school may have additional consequences including suspension of parking and/or loss of parking privileges.

One of our robotics teams here at college park, Texas Torque, had the honor to compete at the District Championship competition for Texas. There were 85 teams split into two divisions. Texas Torque was on the Mercury division and ended qualifications at rank 9 out of 42.

After qualifications we were the second pick of the rank 4 team to compete in the playoff matches. Unfortunately, we were knocked out during round 4 / 5 of playoffs. Even though our district championship run came to an end a little earlier than we were hoping, the students gained a lot of insight and are ready to give it their all-next week at the world championship!

We also won two awards at District Champs. Our first award was the safety award, which congratulates our team due to us handing out safety cards to all the teams and putting safety first. This award also celebrates our safety captain, Victoria Velasquez, because of all the work she has done to not only make sure our team is safe, but that all teams are safe when working with robots and heavy machinery. Our Second award was the innovation in control award which celebrates an innovative control system or application of control components – electrical, mechanical or software – to provide unique machine functions.

Due to our performance at District Champs, we are ranked 13 / 189 competing teams in the entire district of Texas (which includes all Texas teams and even some from New Mexico). We have an amazing robot, and the team put in a lot of time, effort and stress during the competition. 


