Exemption Policy 2024-2025

Seniors:

Fall Semester: May exempt no more than two exams in: Economics, Government, DC Pre-Cal, or DC College Algebra

Spring Semester: May exempt all exams

Juniors, Sophomores and Freshmen:

Fall Semester: No exemptions

Spring Semester: May exempt up to two exams.

<u>Exemption Qualification</u> Spring Semester average of 90-100 and 6 or fewer absences for the year 80-89 and 4 or fewer absences for the year 75-79 and 2 or fewer absences for the year ** 3 tardies count as an absence**
<u>Attendance</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be in attendance on the day and time for the exam.• The following absences do NOT count:<ul style="list-style-type: none">HCP – Doctors visit during part of the school day, in class the rest of the dayFRL – Funeral attendance for close relativeREL – Religious HolidayUIL – UIL-sanctioned EventsEC – Extra-curricularSEV – Special Event on CampusFT – School-sponsored field tripCV – College VisitCRT – Court• Attendance for transfer students will include their attendance and absence record from their previous school.
<u>Missing Assignments</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No zeros for any Major Grades in the 3rd or 4th grading period for Spring exemptions; Z = 0 in grade book (No zeros for any Major Grades in 1st or 2nd grading period for Senior Fall exemptions)• Blanks or X's do not count
<u>Discipline Qualification</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No discipline assignments to ISS or OSS for the semester.• No discipline assignments to DAEP or JJAEP for the school year.
<u>Hold List</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cannot be on the hold list for items/fees from the past or current year.• Must be clear from the list 2 days prior to the beginning of semester exams.
<u>Advanced Courses (DC/AP)</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All students (9-11), who take an AP exam, can earn an additional end of year exemption for each AP class if all other requirements listed above are met. Underclassmen who do not take the AP exam will be required to take the end of year exam.• All students (9-11) in a dual credit class can earn an additional end of year exemption for the College Park portion of each DC class if all other requirements are met. Lone Star College does not have exemptions for their final exam, so you will be required to take the Lone Star College Final exam.

Administrative Note: Administration may change the decision of the exemption for students based on extenuating circumstances. Assistant principals will review and make a recommendation to the Associate Principal of Curriculum and Instruction for approval.
